

RULES OF PROCEDURE

1- Admission requirements

In order to be allowed to enter, to settle on a campsite, you must have been authorised by the person in charge at the reception desk (or by the manager). The fact of staying on the Camping le Grand Pré campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these rules and regulations and the commitment to comply with them.

2- Police formalities

Anyone who needs to stay at least one night in the camp must first present their identity papers to the reception desk and complete the formalities required by the police.

3-Installation

The tent or caravan and all equipment must be set up at the pitch indicated by the manager. Anyone who has a reservation contract, having their caravan or tent installed by a third party must inform the campsite manager.

4- Reception desk

At the reception desk you will find all the information about the services of the campsite, the sports facilities, the tourist attractions of the surroundings and various addresses that may be useful.

5- Fees

Fees are paid at the reception desk. Their amount is fixed according to the tariff opposite. They are due according to the number of nights spent on the pitch (Arrival after 4pm - Departure between 8am and 10am).

All users are invited to inform the reception office of their departure the day before.

6- Noise and silence

Users of the camp are urged to avoid any noise and discussions that might disturb their neighbours.

Sound equipment should be adjusted accordingly, and door and gate closures should be as unobtrusive as possible.

Silence must be total between 11pm and 7am. Only 1 animal allowed per location/weight MAX 10kgs

7- Visitors

Any Visitor or additional camper must report to the reception desk on arrival and may only be admitted with the agreement of the person in charge of the reception desk and under the responsibility of the campers who receive them. Vehicles must remain in the entrance car park. A fee will be charged to each visitor. Prices in force: $2,00 \in$ for a daily visit, $6,00 \in$ with access to the swimming pool.

Visitors must have left the campsite by 10 pm.

8- Vehicle traffic and parking

Inside the campsite vehicles must drive at a limited speed or not. All traffic is forbidden between 23:00 and 7:00 (cars, motorbikes, bicycles, etc...). Only vehicles belonging to the campers staying in the campground are allowed to circulate in the campground. Parking, which is strictly forbidden on the pitches usually occupied by the campsite shelters, must not, moreover, hinder traffic or prevent new arrivals from settling in.

9- Dress and aspects of the facilities

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the camp. It is forbidden to throw polluted water on the ground or in the gutters. Caravanners" must obligatorily dispose of their waste water in the facilities provided for this purpose. Household waste, rubbish of any kind, papers must be deposited in the dustbins. Washing is strictly forbidden. Planting and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden for the camper to drive nails into trees, to cut branches, to make plantations. It is also not allowed to delimit the site of a facility by personal means or to dig up the ground. Any damage to the vegetation, the ground or the facilities will be at the expense of the perpetrator. For all travel, please use the lanes provided for this purpose.

10- Security

A) FIRE . Open fires and electric barbecues are strictly forbidden. The stoves must be kept in good working order.

Fire extinguishers are available to all. In case of fire, immediately notify the management. A first aid kit is available at the reception desk.

B) THEFT: The management is only responsible for items left at the office. Immediately report the presence of any suspicious person in the camp to the person in charge.

Although security is provided, campers are invited to take the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment.

11- Games

No violent or disturbing games may be organised in the vicinity of the facilities. The meeting room cannot be used for moving games.

12- Camp leader

He is responsible for the order and good running of the camp. He has the duty to punish serious movements under the rules and if necessary to expel their perpetrators.
